What is Performing Arts?

Performing Arts is the study of Acting, Theatre roles , Production Arts (design skills) and Music.



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Why is Performing Arts important?

Performing Arts lessons will help you learn transferable skills that can be used in all your other subjects such as communication, group work and public speaking. Exploring a number of different topics through role play, instruments and performance will be exciting and engaging.

Extra-Curricular

Drama Club: A weekly lunch time club where you can make new friends from all year groups in KS3. Students will work towards a termly performance.

Drama Company: A weekly after school club, developing acting skills to perform devised and scripted work

School Shows and Theatre Trips: We like to give our students the opportunity to attend trips throughout their time at Cardinal Newman. This can include going to the theatre to watch shows in The West End and theatre companies visiting school to run workshops.

Towards the end of the academic year, we put together a whole school

musical production or a showcase of performance work, where students from all clubs can take part, rehearsing and making friends with their peers from other year groups in the school.
